Our Programs

Our half-day **Preschool** program is for children ages 3-4 and meets four days a week. Our full day **Pre-Kindergarten** program is for children ages 4-5 and meets five days a week.



Why choose Listen and Talk for your child?

Small Classes: our pre-k classes have no more than 10 students and our preschool classes have no more than 6 students

Teacher to Student Ratio: each classroom has a teacher and an assistant for a 1 to 5 (pre-k) or 1 to 3 (preschool) teacher to student ratio
